5. Transportations

The City of Lisbon is capital of Portugal and lies in the western Iberian Peninsula on the Atlantic Ocean and the River Tagus.



Recommended travel to Lisbon by air through the Lisbon Airport (official site: https://www.ana.pt/en/lis/home), located just 20 minutes away from the city center. Getting to or coming from the Lisbon Airport is easy. You have at your service an efficient public transportation network that can ensure you arrive where you need to go quickly and comfortably. Travel by Airplane:

Lisbon is served by Lisbon Airport (Aeroporto da Portela) located at north of the city and at approximately 5 km from the city center. From the airport it is possible to travel to the city by taxi, subway or bus.

Travel by Taxi:

Traveling by taxi is usually the fastest and more comfortable way to travel upon arrival. The taxi fare from the airport to city center (and vice-versa) is around $15-20 \in$, depending on traffic and whether the airport tax of $5 \in$ is applied (some taxi drivers do not apply it).

Travel in the city:

The public transport system of Lisbon is run by Carris-Metro. Tickets can be bought for each journey on buses and trams or at subway stations, but the cheapest way to travel is to use prepurchased cards (LisboaViva cards) that can be charged either with journeys or money. 

Location Maps


