Scope

This document details [IALA](#) policy on the use of the [IALA](#) Wiki for the storage of information related to the work of [IALA](#).

Background

The [IALA](#) Wiki is part of the [IALA](#) Committee knowledge sharing toolbox. It is a place where [IALA](#) committee members can share information, collaborate on developing [IALA](#) Guidelines and Recommendations, and store informal information of importance from their past and future work.

The [IALA](#) Wiki has the capability to search content stored in the Wiki that allows members to easily locate topics and information of interest.

Content

The [IALA](#) Wiki can be used by committee members for storage of information such as:

- *Innovative Ideas* - Tracking new ideas relating to the future of [IALA](#) and its the committees
- *Topics of Interest* Information developed by Committee members for updating members on topics of interest

- *Case Studies*, Interesting presentations and videos from committee members
- *Information Papers* - Valuable information that did not make it into formal [IALA](#) output documents
- *Results of AtoN Trials and Experiments* conducted by committee members
- *Lessons Learned* - Information relating to all aspects of AtoN design, maintenance and governance
- *Input Papers* from committee meetings that contain additional information that does not end up in [IALA](#) Guidance documents
- *Draft Recommendations and Guidelines* in relation to the work of [IALA](#) Committees
- *IALA Bulletin* back issues of the [IALA](#) Bulletin
- *Obsolete IALA documents* such as obsolete Guidelines, Recommendations and Information Papers

[IALA](#) Wiki should *NOT* contain:

- Political, Commercial or Religious Propaganda

Access

The [IALA](#)-Wiki is only accessible by Committee members, the [IALA](#) Council and the [IALA](#) Secretariat.

Responsibilities
